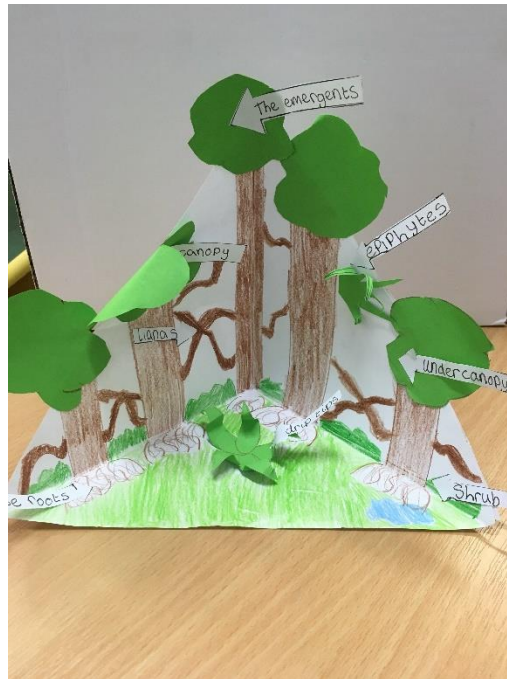

Triarama to display research work

This week is all about researching your chosen topic. How you research is up to you - use the internet/ books/ ask people at home. Once you have gathered the information to answer some of the questions you have you need to think of a way to display the facts. You could make a booklet, a poster or you could try a Triarama. A triarama is a way to display information in a 3D model made of triangles. I have put instruction below of how to make one. Plus there are some photos of some finished ones to give you some inspiration.



How to make a Triarama

You will need 4 pieces of paper

Some glue

A pair of scissors

(Photos below)

1. Cut all your paper so they are square (the easiest way to do this is to fold the corner across and cup of the strip of paper left.)

2. Once you have 4 square pieces of paper, fold in to four diagonally, so when you open the up there is a cross through the middle.
3. Cut a straight line from 1 corner to the centre point on each piece of paper.
4. Fold one flap across another flap and glue so your paper stands up in a triangle shape.
5. Finally, glue the 4 triangles/pyramids back to back so you have 4 sections for your information/ pictures etc

Top tip: you may want to write the information on your model before sticking it all together.
