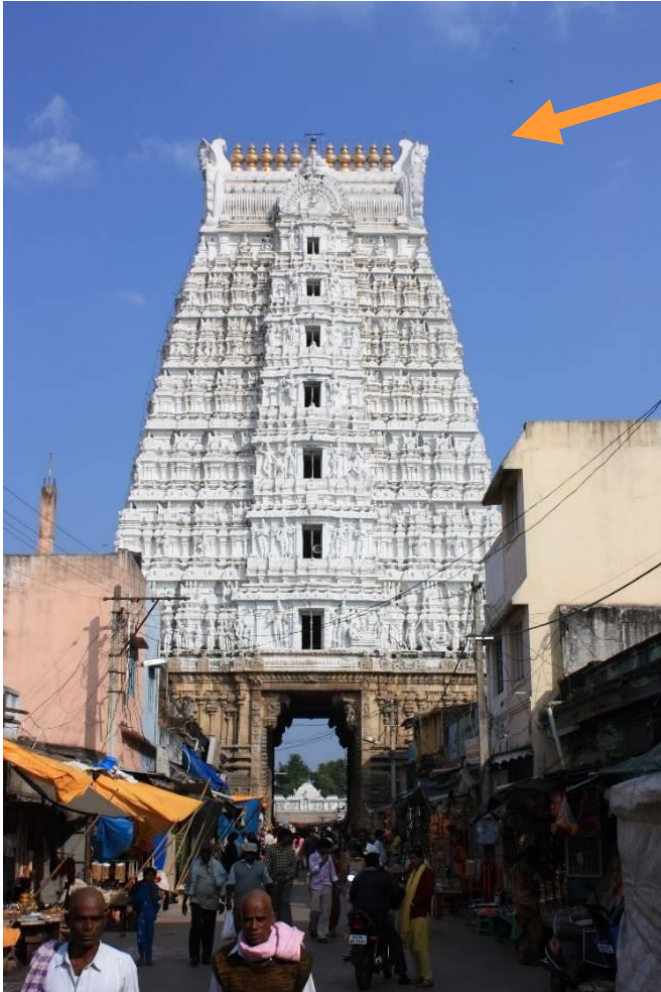


Hinduism and Pilgrimages

Pilgrimage forms an important part of Hinduism. Hindus go on pilgrimage to a range of sites including temples and mountains.

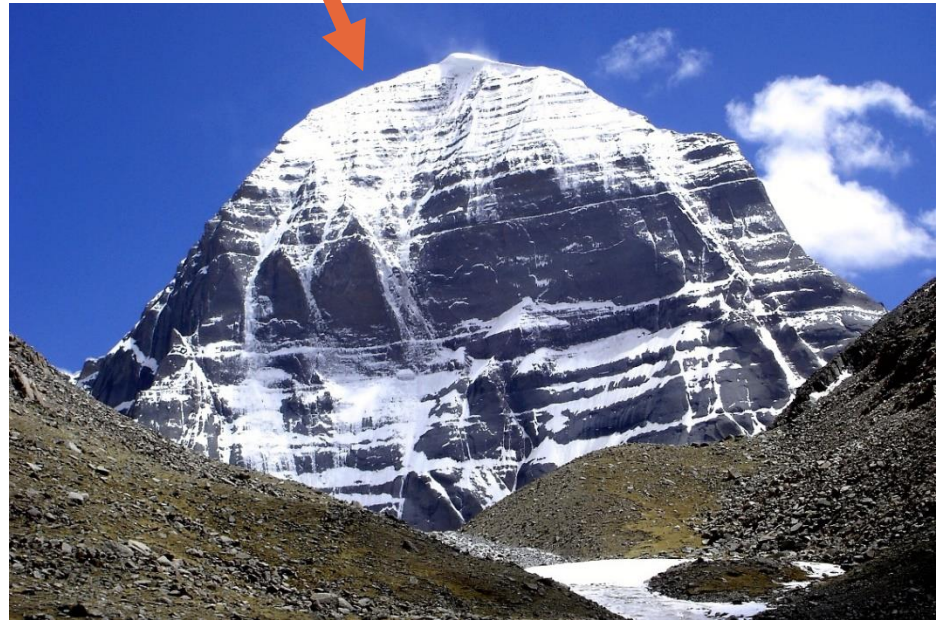

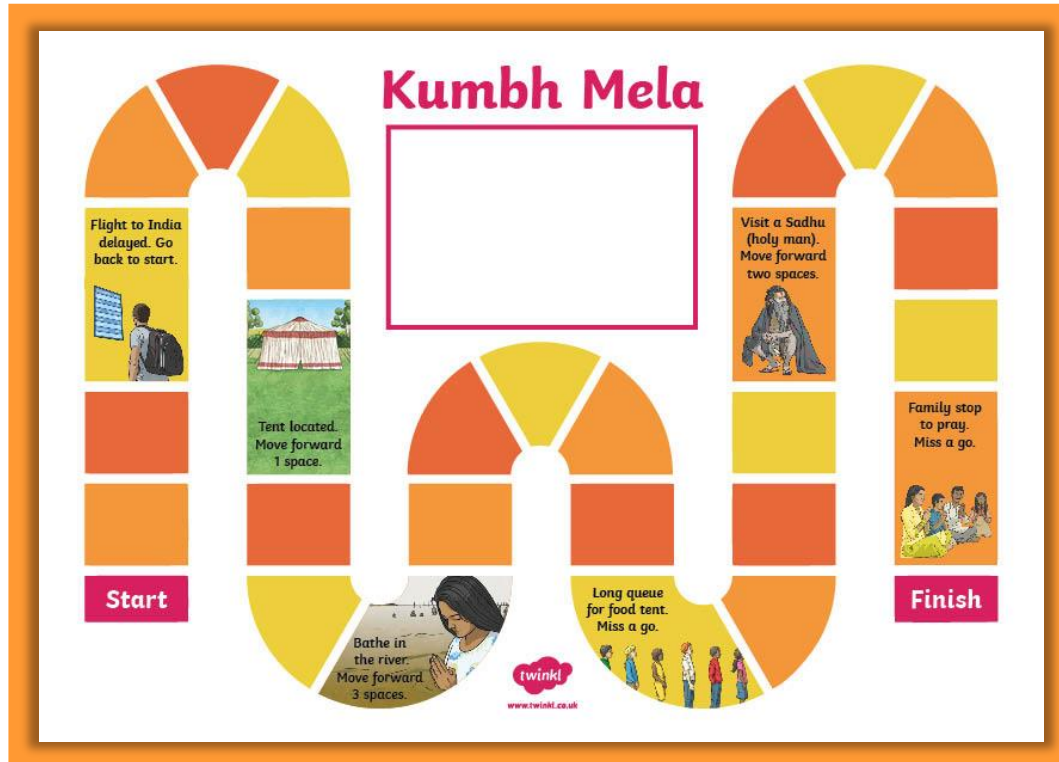

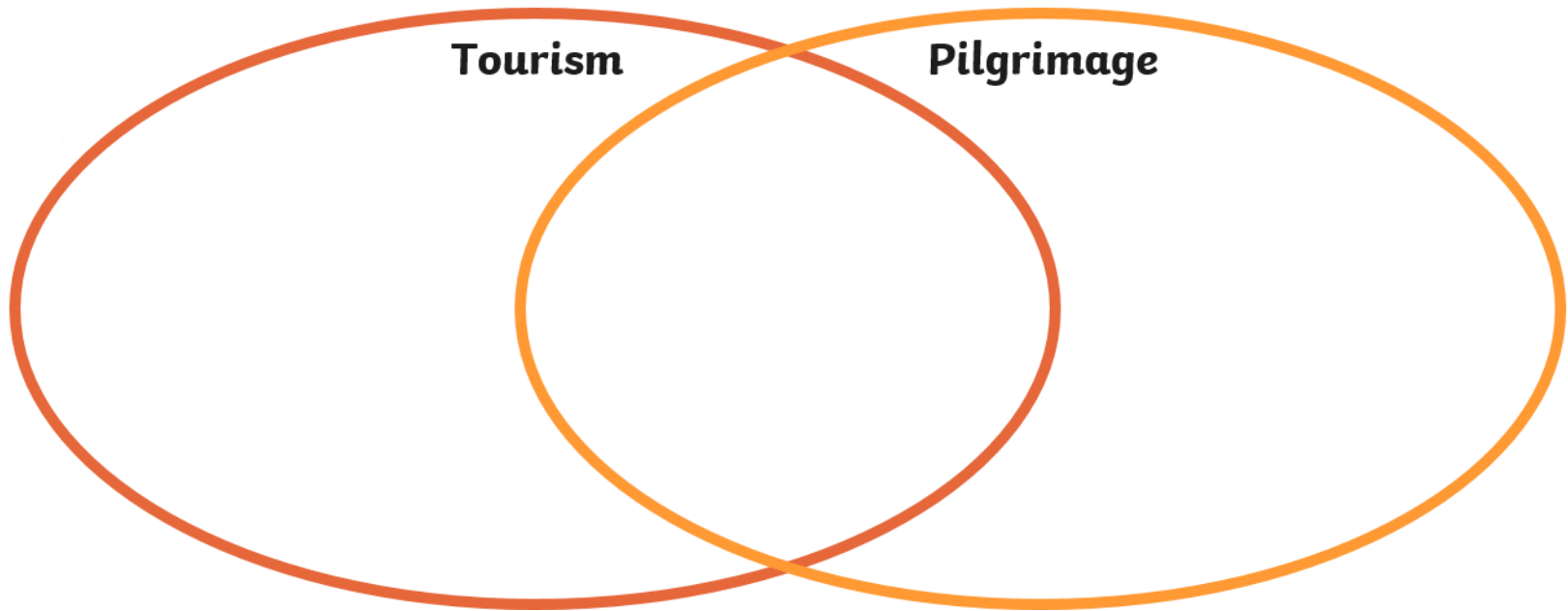
